It is certified that:-

- The Inspection consisting of Dr. Shyla R.J.B. Yoganand & Dr. R. Shylajakumari, Professors, Government Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Bangalore has visited Yenepoya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore on 25-04-2017 and submitted report on 26-04-2017 the Inspection team has recommended for Starting of New Ayurvedic Medical College. Hence, the permission may be granted to start the New Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital with the name of Yenepoya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore. The College is attached with 100 bedded Ayurvedic Hospital called Yenepoya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore which has been established in the year 2015.
- b) It is desirable to establish an Ayurveda College in the public interest and starting a new BAMS Degree course with an Intake Capacity of 100 seats.
- c) Establishment of Ayurveda College and starting BAMS Degree Course at Mangaluru by Yenepoya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore is feasible.

It is also certified that adequate infrastructure and material as per norms of the Central Council of Indian Medicine are available, with proposed Medical College. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Ayurveda College as per Central Council of Indian Medicine norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Council / Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.
