7	<p>Brief report of the event</p> <p><i>(Please describe the objectives of the event and benefit (impact) to students, teachers, patients, or society)</i></p> <p>The NSS Unit of YAMCH has organized a 7-Day Special Residential Camp from 20th November 2025 to 26th November 2025 in the DKZP, Higher Primary School, Kallarakodi Narinagana adopted village. The objective of the camp was to promote community development, health awareness, cleanliness, environmental protection, social responsibility, and student personality development through disciplined teamwork and service learning.</p> <p>A total of 95 NSS volunteers participated enthusiastically. The volunteers were divided into five teams, each assigned specific responsibilities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Survey Team 2. Cleaning & Sanitation Team 3. Food & Cooking Team 4. Health Camp Team 5. Cultural & Snehalaya Visit Team <p>The daily camp timings were from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM, consisting of yoga, breakfast, team briefings, health camps, field activities, guest talks, reflections, and cultural interactions.</p> <p>Camp Objectives</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To promote social awareness and community responsibility among volunteers. • To conduct a health screening camp for villagers. • To undertake village survey, identifying health, sanitation, and socio-economic conditions. • To perform cleaning and sanitation activities in public areas. • To organize tree plantation drive for environmental conservation. • To visit the Snehalaya (care home) and interact with residents. • To develop leadership, teamwork, discipline, and cultural values among NSS volunteers. <p>On 20th November 2025 (Inauguration Day)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Camp began at 9:00 AM with Prayer. • Inaugural Ceremony conducted in presence of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Pro Vice Chancellor, Principal, ○ NSS Coordinator & Program Officer ○ Village President, PDO ○ Local dignitaries • Volunteers were oriented about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ NSS motto “Not Me, But You” ○ Goals of the 7-day camp ○ Team allocation and duties • Ice-breaking activities were conducted to build teamwork. <p>The Camp progressed with a well-structured schedule from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, beginning each morning with Yoga and physical exercises, followed by breakfast and briefing on the day’s duties. The students were divided into five teams—Survey Team, Cleaning Team, Food & Cooking Team, Health Camp Team, and Cultural & Snehalaya Visit Team—and each team performed its assigned responsibilities with discipline and enthusiasm. The Health Camp Team conducted daily health check-ups, basic screenings, and health awareness sessions for</p>
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villagers, with special focus on women, children, and elderly individuals. The Survey Team carried out a house-to-house socio-economic and health-related survey, documenting data such as sanitation practices, water sources, health conditions, education status, and government scheme awareness. Along with survey work, students also participated in tree plantation drives, encouraging environmental sustainability.

Meanwhile, the Snehalaya Visit Team visited the Snehalaya center, interacted with residents, provided emotional support, and organized engaging activities for children and elderly individuals. The Cleaning Team undertook daily cleanliness drives, focusing on street sweeping, drainage cleaning, waste segregation, plastic collection, and promoting “Swachh Gaon – Swasth Gaon” practices among villagers. The Food & Cooking Team prepared nutritious meals for all volunteers and maintained hygiene in the kitchen area. Every evening, the Cultural Team organized awareness-based cultural programs, including street plays (Nukkad Natak), songs, skits, and group activities on themes like health, hygiene, environment protection, women empowerment, and education. At the end of each day, all teams participated in Reflection (अवलोकन) sessions, where volunteers shared experiences, challenges, observations, and learnings, fostering leadership, teamwork, and social responsibility. These continuous activities from Day 2 to Day 6 helped the volunteers deeply understand community needs while actively contributing to village development.

On 26th November 2025 camp last day ended with Valedictory Day

Outcomes of the Camp

- 95 students gained **hands-on community service experience**.
- 200 + villagers benefited from the health camp.
- Over 420 households were surveyed.
- Improved sanitation and waste-free surroundings in the village.
- Bonding established between volunteers and village community.
- Volunteers showcased leadership, teamwork, discipline, communication, and empathy.

- Social inequality and rural challenges
- Importance of cleanliness and hygiene
- Value of compassion and human connection
- Understanding grassroots health conditions
- Realizing the transformative power of NSS service
