Brief report of the event

सम्मतिपत्ति: 2025, a National Conference on Medical Sanskrit was organised by the Department of Samhita, Siddhanta, and Sanskrit at Yenepoya Ayurveda Medical College & Hospital, a constituent unit of Yenepoya (Deemed to be University), on the 1st of February, 2025, at the auditorium of YAMCH, Naringana.

The conference was formally inaugurated in the morning session, in the presence of Dr. B. H. Sripathi Rao, Pro Vice-Chancellor of Yenepoya (Deemed to be University), as the Chief Guest. Dr. S. Venugopalan, Professor from the Department of Oriental Studies and Research, SASTRA University, Thanjavur, and Prof. Ramadas P. V., Professor from Amrita School of Ayurveda, Kollam, were the distinguished resource persons. Dr. Gururaja H, Principal/Dean of Yenepoya Ayurveda Medical College & Hospital, presided over the function. Dr. Shubhada, Vice Principal, and Dr. Subhash Rai, Medical Superintendent, YAMCH, were the other dignitaries present on the Dias.

The event commenced with a welcome address from DrShrikanth P H, Head of the Department of Samhita, Siddhanta, and Sanskrit; The inaugural session also saw the traditional lighting of the lamp by Dr B. H. Sripathi Rao and other dignitaries on the dais.

Dr. Sripathi Rao delivered the inaugural address, emphasizing the need to create ecosystems for integrative research to revalidate Ayurveda. The Presidential Address was delivered by DrGururaja H, highlighting the importance of collaboration in research and encouraging delegates to work together to advance Ayurveda.

The session concluded with a vote of thanks from Dr. Divyarani, the organizing secretary.

The conference proceeded with two major scientific sessions:

1. **First Scientific Session (Pre-Lunch)** – Dr. S. Venugopalan from SASTRA University delivered an engaging keynote address.
2. **Second Scientific Session (Post-Lunch)** – Prof. Ramadas P. V. from Amrita School of Ayurveda presented the *Application of Medical Sanskrit* in contemporary medical practice.

In addition to these sessions, there were parallel paper and poster presentations from delegates across various categories, including UG, PG, PhD/Researcher, and Faculty.

The Colloquium witnessed 281 delegates, including 141 external delegates. Among the

external delegates, 121 were from various institutes in Karnataka. In contrast, others came from different parts of the country, including Kerala, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra, Gujarat, and New Delhi.

The breakdown of delegate categories included:

- 63 UG delegates were from Karnataka
- 35 PG delegates, 3 from Harayana, 3 from MP, 1 from Uttara Khand
- 4 PhD delegates, 1 from Kerala, 1 from New Delhi, 2 from Karnataka
- The remaining participants, 35, were faculty members. 1 from Gujarat, 2 from Kerala, 1 from Uttara Pradesh, 1 from Odisha, 1 from Maharastra, and 26 from Karnataka.

There were 64 paper presentations and 07 poster presentations from UG students. Best Paper & Best Poster were awarded.

The Himalaya Wellness Company played a key role in supporting the conference by offering sponsorship, further contributing to the event's success.

The valedictory program took place in the presence of Prof. Ramadas P. V. from Amrita School of Ayurveda, who served as the Chief Guest. Dr. Gururaja H, Principal of Yenepoya Ayurveda Medical College & Hospital; Dr. Shubhada, Vice Principal; Dr. Subhash Rai, Medical Superintendent, YAMCH; and Dr. Shrikanth P H, HOD of the Department of Samhita; Siddhanta, and Sanskrit, were also present at the ceremony.

Dr. Shilpa K, Assistant Professor from the Department of Kayachikitsa, and Dr. Surya Brijesh, Assistant Professor from the Department of Samhita, Siddhanta, and Sanskrit, served as the Masters of Ceremony for the Inaugural and Valedictory Programs, respectively.
