12	<p>Brief report of the event:</p> <p>A National Level Faculty Development Programme on “<i>Performance Assessment – Bridging Theory and Practice</i>” was organised by Yenepoya Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital in association with Yenepoya Centre for Faculty Development (YEN-FDC) on 29/10/2025 at YAMCH. The event saw active participation from 38 external delegates representing various colleges from different parts of India, along with 24 internal faculty members.</p> <p>The programme aimed to provide hands-on understanding of modern assessment methods in medical education, bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application.</p> <p>The technical sessions were conducted by eminent resource persons with expertise in the field of medical education and assessment. The Keynote Address was delivered by Dr. Animesh Jain, who highlighted the importance of bridging theory and practice in performance assessment and aligning evaluation tools with competency-based educational objectives. Dr. Meera Jacob conducted the first and second sessions on “<i>Principles, Structure and Fundamentals of OSCE/OSPE</i>” and “<i>Practical Demonstration of OSCE/OSPE</i>”, providing participants with both theoretical insights and hands-on exposure to structured clinical and practical examinations. Dr. Swaroop Raj B.V. conducted the third session on “<i>Theory and Demonstration: DOPS</i>”, elaborating on direct observation techniques for evaluating procedural competencies. The fourth session on “<i>Theory and Demonstration: Mini CEX</i>” was led by Dr. Janardhana Aithala P., who emphasized formative assessment through structured clinical encounters. The fifth and final technical session was conducted by Dr. Vidya Hegde, who presented an overview of “<i>Portfolio and Multisource Feedback</i>” as integral components of holistic performance evaluation.</p> <p>The programme concluded with a Valedictory Session, during which participants shared positive feedback regarding the academic relevance, interactive nature, and practical applicability of the sessions. Certificates were distributed to all participants, and the event was formally closed with expressions of gratitude to the resource persons and delegates by Dr. Priya Pradeep, Organising chairperson.</p>
